ORDER OF ADOPTION

Now on this 24th day of February, 1936, this matter coming on in its regular order for hearing upon the petition of Allegra O'Rouark for t adoption of Karl Rauch, a minor, the petitioner being represented by her attorneys, Bixby & Neal, and for the adoption of a boy child born at Wenatche ~~Washington~~ Washington, March 11, 1932, who is now 4 years of age, and for sometime has in the possession of your petitioner, having been released to her by the ~~MISSIONARY SISTERS OF THE SACRED HEART~~ ~~BEEN~~ the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart for the purpose of adoption if deemed advisable by your petitioner, and the written consent to the adoption of the minor, Karl Rauch, having been obtained from Gust and Elaine Rauch, father and mother respectively, and the written consent for adoption of said boy child born at Wenatchee, Washington, March, 11, 1932 out of wedlock, was regularly obtained and given to the Missionary Sisters of the Sacred Heart to the adoption of said boy child born at Wenatchee, Washington, March 11, 1932 by the natural mother of said child Agnes Marie Flaherty, ^{Now deceased} and the court having heretofore examined the said Allegra O'Rouark and being satisfied from said examination that the said Allegra O'Rouark of her own free will and accord desires the adoption of the said boy child born at Wenatchee, Washington, March 11, 1932 and the said Karl Rauch, and the court having read the petition and having heard the evidence and being advised in the premises, the court is satisfied and finds:

That the said Allegra O'Rouark is an inhabitant of the State of Washington and a resident of Whatcom County, Washington; that Gust and Elaine Rauch are the parents of the said Karl Rauch, a minor, now 2 years and 3 months of age, and that both of the parents of said child, Karl Rauch, have executed their consent in writing to the adoption of said child, Karl Rauch, by Allegra O'Rouark as her own child, and that the said Gust Rauch and Elaine Rauch be deprived of all rights of every kind in and to said child.

That the Missionary Sisters of Sacred Heart, through Mother Superior Gesuina, having obtained the relinquishment and consent from the mother of said boy child born at Wenatchee, Washington, March 11, 1932, give consent to the adoption of said boy child born at Wenatchee, Washington, by Allegra O'Rouark and that the mother of said child and the Missionary Sisters of Sacred Heart be deprived of all rights of every kind and description in and to said child.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That said relinquishment and consent for the adoption of said child born at Wenatchee, Washington, has herein received, and all matters pertaining thereto, be kept open to the public, all in accordance with the laws of the State of Washington.
